When May 1st was first celebrated as Lei Day in Hawai'i in 1928, Leonard "Red" Hawk wasted no time in composing this cheerful song that has become the "official" song of Lei Day. At one time, we all sang and knew this song! If you know it, sing along!

Ka Papa 'Ekolu: Kīlauea

"Lei Mānoa" is a chant that speaks to us about the wonders around us in the midst of Mānoa. The third grade students have made their own ipu, dancing gourds, to beat out their rhythms in a story of Pele in the chant, "Kīlauea." They leave us with the "Oli Mahalo," to thank all of you in joining us.

Nā Kamāli'i Wāhine o Case Middle School: Moanike'ala

The title translates as "Fragrance-that-lingers-in-the-air." This song is one of those that will linger in your thoughts well after you hear it and see it in hula.

Ka Papa 'Elua: Ka Wai 'O Kapunahou




