#### May Day is Lei Day

When May 1st was first celebrated as Lei Day in Hawai'i in 1928, Leonard "Red" Hawk wasted no time in composing this cheerful song that has become the "official" song of Lei Day. At one time, we all sang and knew this song! If you know it, sing along!

#### Ka Papa 'Elima: E Pele, E Pele Ka'uka'u Lī 'Ana

Going to Kīlauea where the goddess Pele makes her home in Halema'uma'u is special to very many people. The dancers let Pele know that they are visiting her with a distictive clap and refrains. "E Pele, E Pele Ka'uka'u Lī 'Ana" is descriptive of the sights, sounds and movements of the fire goddess. They leave their visit to the volcano with the hula ho'i of Kīlauea.

#### Nā Kamāli'i Wāhine o Case Middle School: Moanike'ala

The title translates as "Fragrance-that-lingers-in-the-air." This song is one of those that will linger in your thoughts well after you hear it and see it in hula.

#### Ka Papa 'Ehā: Hanohano 'O Mānoa

Making their entrance with a traditional dance, "Ho'opuka," the dancers take their place to perform a hula noho kālā'au, a seated dance with rhythm sticks, "Hanohano 'O Mānoa." Their hula honors Queen Ka'ahumanu who had the land of Kapunahou given to us to erect a school. The dancers leave you with their hula ho'i (exit dance).

#### Nā Pa'a Kāhili o Case Middle School: Aloha 'la 'o Wai'anae

Wai'anae on O'ahu's west coast is home to Ka'ala, the highest elevation in the Wai'anae mountains. The coconut tree grove, Pōka'ī, is long gone but the memory of its sweetest coconuts are still celebrated. Our pa'a kāhili, kāhili bearers, will tell you about Wai'anae with their hula.

#### Mō'ī Wahine o Case Middle School: Lovely 'Ala Mēlia

The subtle sweetness of plumeria, mēlia, is lovely because it reminds us of significant times in our lives. Lei Day is one of those times. Our Case Middle School Lei Queen dances of the plumeria's special perfume.

#### Hawai'i Aloha

There is no other song that captures the heart and soul of Hawai'i other than "Hawa'i Aloha." The title says it all, "Hawai'i is Loved." Reverend Lorenzo Lyons ("Makua Laiana") felt that Hawai'i is love embodied in all its wondrous beauty. It's customary for everyone to join hands and voices in "Hawai'i Aloha."


