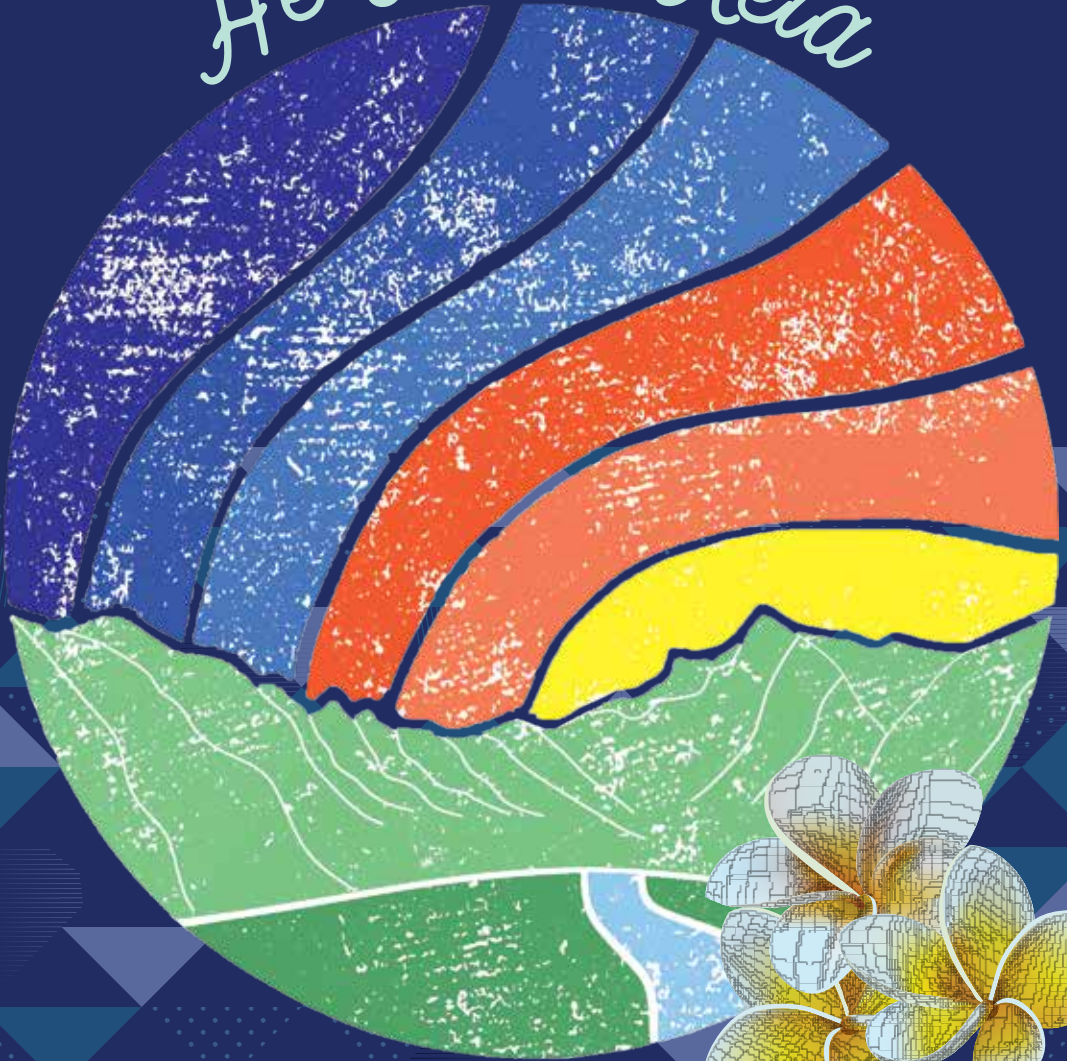

Lei Nani / Pua 'Āhihi

A lei signifies the encompassing love of family and friends. We cherish our beautiful lei and wear it proudly, as it reminds us of the people and places that are foundational and inspiring in our lives. Our Mō'i Wahine dances *Lei Nani*, composed by Charles Namahoe, to honor her first Kumu Hula, Auntie Hattie Phillips, followed by *Pua 'Āhihi*, another lovely mele composed by Maddy Lam for Kahauani Lake as a gift to his wife, Ma'iki Aiu. She honors the legacy of the Aiu 'ohana and her Kumu, Ka'iliihiwa Vaughan, in *Pua 'Āhihi*.

Hawai'i Aloha

The final mele in our hō'ike is the well-known composition, *Hawai'i Aloha*. Written by Reverend Lorenzo Lyons, affectionately known as Makua Laiana, this mele was originally composed as a hymn and set to the tune of James McGranahan's *I left It All With Jesus*. As a member of the fifth company of missionaries from the American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Missions, Makua Laiana arrived in 1832 in Kohala, Hawai'i. There he served the Waimea community until his passing in 1886. To our knowledge, one of his sons was a Punahou School graduate who went on to Williams College, and later became a legislator in the Hawaiian Kingdom. During his lifetime, Makua Laiana is credited with erecting 14 churches, one being 'Imiola Church where he is buried. Makua Laiana was said to be one of the most fluent Hawaiian speaking missionaries to have lived in the islands and was said to be one of the few who had come to love Hawai'i more than his homeland, dedicating himself to the service of this place and pledging his allegiance to the King and Kingdom of Hawai'i. As we end our program, please stand and join in song as we honor Makua Laiana and our beloved Hawai'i aloha.
